As part of seasonal traditions, in Denmark we celebrate Saint Hans — the longest day of the year. Saint Hans has long been linked to various notions of magic and witchcraft. In ancient times, it was believed that the forces of nature were at their peak and most powerful during midsummer, making it a time of both wonder and danger. This belief is marked with a celebration, where Sødisbakke's witch takes center stage.

The witch is a captivating figure, dancing and playing pranks on the residents, adding an element of fun and surprise to the festivities. She also performs at the Halloween party in October, keeping the magic alive throughout the year.
